

May 10, 2016

The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by A. Dham at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

Present: M. Bullick, A. Dham, R. Graham A. Metricarti, M. Stehman and T. Weikel

Absent: T. Moyer

Also Present: Mayor J. Guest, Solicitor R. Brant, and Manager M. Leonard

The minutes of the April 12 & April 25, 2016 meetings were approved as distributed upon a motion by T. Weikel seconded by M. Stehman. Motion passed unanimously.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT & COMMUNICATIONS:

Manager Leonard presented to council a mill & overlay street project using Liquid Fuel dollars. The project covers Oak Street from 5th Avenue to North 7th Avenue, and North 7th Avenue from Pine Street to Elm Street. Motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti to approve the advertisement in the newspaper for construction of the CDBG Grant Project B15-03-107, North 6th Avenue Street Improvement Project. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard reported that a tractor and trailer knocked down two telephone poles at the sewer plant which disconnected the cable and phone system.

Manager Leonard asked council on the status of the letter from Sacred Heart Church regarding making the north side of Washington Street two hour parking with a permit. The committee stated that the church has a parking lot and found it was not needed at this time. The committee will continue to monitor the issue.

VISITORS:

No visitors spoke at the meeting.

FINANCE COMMITTEE:

Disbursements in the amount of \$136,183.43 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE:

M. Bullick wanted to discuss the amount of money we contribute to the fire company compared to what Upper Providence Township contributes to our fire company, and the amount of calls in Upper Providence Township. Council discussed this issue and asked the manager to get a copy of the agreement from Upper Providence Township.

SOLICITOR:

Permission to advertise the Conditional Use Hearing for United Methodist Church (Daycare) for May 31st by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

Solicitor Brant presented a hearing on Ordinance #882 regarding the amendments to the promotional criteria for the positions of Corporal and Sergeant. Mr. Brant asked if there were any questions from the audience and there were none. Mr. Brant asked council if anyone had any questions and there were none. Motion by M. Bullick seconded by M. Stehman by roll call vote. Mr. Bullick-yes, Mr. Dham-yes, Mr. Graham- yes, Ms. Metricarti-yes, Mr. Stehman-yes, Mr. Weikel-yes. Motion passed 6-0.

ADJOURNMENT:

The meeting was adjourned at 7:40P.M. upon a motion by A. Metricarti seconded by T. Weikel. The motion passed unanimously.
