

June 28, 2016

The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by A. Dham at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

Present: M. Bullick, A. Dham, R. Graham, A. Metricarti, T. Moyer, M. Stehman, and T. Weikel

Also present: Mayor J. Guest, and Manager M. Leonard

The Treasurers Report and Sewer & Solid Waste Collection Report for May 2016 was presented and accepted upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by T. Moyer. Motion passed unanimously.

#### BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT & COMMUNICATIONS:

Spring Ford School District requested permission from Borough Council to hold the Homecoming Parade on Saturday October 22, 2016 starting at 12:00 (noon) and the same route as last year. Motion to give the Spring Ford School District permission to parade down Main Street from South 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue to North 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue, to Green Street, to the 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Center. Motion by M. Bullick seconded by A. Metricarti to give permission to the school district. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard read a letter from the Borough Planning Commission that met on April 4, 2016 that voted and passed a motion to recommend that Borough Council adopt the March 28, 2016 draft of the High Priority Zoning Amendment. The County has the changes and should be back sometime in July.

#### FINANCE COMMITTEE:

Disbursements in the amount of \$148,186.55 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

T. Weikel informed Council of a resolution regarding resetting the rate of the sewer bond from 4.517% and the rate today at 1.911%. In resetting the rate the Borough could realize a savings of around \$635,000. Resolution #2016-8 was presented to Council to reset the rate of the sewer bond. Motion by T. Weikel seconded by M. Stehman. Motion passed unanimously.

#### WASTE WATER COMMITTEE:

The report of the Waste Water Treatment Plant Superintendent for the month of May 2016 was presented and accepted upon motion of M. Stehman seconded by A. Metricarti. The motion passed unanimously.

#### PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE:

The report of the Director of Public Works for the month of May 2016 was presented and accepted upon motion by R. Graham seconded by A. Metricarti. The motion passed unanimously.

The report of the Code Enforcement Officer for the month of May 2016 was presented and accepted upon motion by R. Graham seconded by A. Metricarti. The motion passed unanimously.

President A. Dham stated at the Master Plan meeting it was suggested that the Industrial Park be inspected by the Building Inspector and Fire Marshal for any violations on the property.

**PARK & RECREATION COMMITTEE:**

The minutes of the June 2, 2016 committee meeting were presented and accept upon motion by T. Moyer seconded by M. Bullick. The motion passed unanimously.

**PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE:**

The report of the Chief of Police for the month of May 2016 were presented and accepted upon motion by M. Bullick seconded by T. Moyer. The motion passed unanimously.

A. Dham reported to Council that Chief Nerlinger attended the FBI Mid Atlantic Law Enforcement Executive Development Seminar.

The report of the Borough Fire Marshal for the month of May 2016 was presented and accepted upon motion by M. Bullick seconded by T. Moyer. The motion passed unanimously.

**PLANNING COMMISSION:**

The next Planning Commission meeting is September 12, 2016.

A. Dham stated that the Comprehensive Master Plan survey will be on the website of the borough. Everyone is asked to participate with ideas for the future of the Borough.

**ADJOURNMENT:**

The meeting was adjourned at 7:38 P.M. upon a motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti. The motion passed unanimously.
