

May 11, 2017

The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by Vice President Matt Stehman at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

Present: M. Bullick, J. Moskal, M. Stehman and T. Weikel  
Also Present: Manager M. Leonard

Absent: Anil Dham, Alexandra Metricarti, Tiffany Moyer, and Mayor John Guest

The minutes of the April 11 & April 25, 2017 meetings were approved as distributed upon motion of T. Weikel seconded by M. Bullick. The motion passed unanimously.

**BOROUGH MANAGER’S REPORT & COMMUNICATIONS:**

Manager Leonard reported that the lowest bidder for S. 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue from Main Street to Washington Street is GoreCon, Inc. in the amount of \$70,795.50. Motion to approve GoreCon, Inc. by M. Bullick seconded by T. Weikel. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard asked Council if they wanted a letter sent to the Zoning Hearing Board that they were not opposed to Mr. Lewis’s sign, and that Council will provide Mr. Lewis with an easement for the sign located between the railroad station and North First Avenue. Motion by T. Weikel seconded by M. Bullick that a letter be sent to the Zoning Hearing Board. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard presented Council with a price to grind stumps at Victory Park from our public works director. The lowest price was RHD Landscape in the amount of \$450.00. Motion by M. Bullick seconded by J. Moskal. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard presented a price for repairing and replacing the fence at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue & Arch Street parking lot. The lowest price was by Montco Fence in the amount of \$2,450. Motion by J. Moskal seconded by M. Bullick. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard informed Council that the wall collapsed in the rear of 426 Chestnut Street. The wall is owned by the Borough of Royersford. The lowest bidder is R&S Hardscape in the amount of \$6,650. Motion by T. Weikel to repair the wall seconded by J. Moskal. Motion passed unanimously.

Meals on Wheels are looking for volunteers.

The Zoning Hearing Board meeting is scheduled for May 16, 2017 at 7PM regarding Lewis Environmental's sign.

Manager Leonard reported that the boat ramp is completed.

Manager Leonard presented the date of September 16, 2017 as the date of the Royersford Fire Company's Housing Parade starting out at Spring-Ford High School, to Main Street, to South 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, to Myrtle Street.

Manager Leonard presented a sewer agreement to Council for the assignment from Limerick Township Sewer Plant to Aqua the new owner of Limerick sewer plant; all Council got a copy. Motion by T. Weikel seconded by J. Moskal. Motion passed unanimously.

#### VISITORS:

Amy Demchik stated she had an employee at The Open Door who wanted to know who she can talk to at the borough because they might be able to get free or low cost flowers. Manager Leonard asked her to contact our Public Workers Director.

William Clemens, 515 Arch Street, asked if the land that Mr. Lewis's sign is going on is open space. Manager Leonard stated that yes it was open space and Borough Council will be giving Mr. Lewis an easement to put the sign on borough property.

#### FINANCE COMMITTEE:

Disbursements in the amount of \$134,137.57 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by M. Bullick. The motion passed unanimously.

#### PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE:

The report of the Royersford Fire Department for the month of April 2017 was presented and accepted upon motion by M. Bullick seconded by T. Weikel. Motion passed unanimously.

#### PERSONNEL COMMITTEE:

T. Weikel made a motion to appoint Amanda Mullery to the Park and Recreation Committee seconded by M. Bullick. Motion passed unanimously.

T. Weikel made a motion to appoint Monique Kelly and Christine Hefner as permanent members to the Human Relation Board, and Amy Demchik as the alternate member seconded by J. Moskal. Motion passed unanimously.

#### ADJOURNMENT:

The meeting was adjourned at 7:30 P.M. upon a motion by T. Weikel seconded by M. Bullick. The motion passed unanimously.
