

August 29, 2017

The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by President Anil Dham at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

Present: M. Bullick, A. Dham, A. Metricarti, J. Moskal, T. Moyer, M. Stehman, and T. Weikel

Also Present: Mayor J. Guest, and Manager M. Leonard

The Treasurers Report and Sewer & Solid Waste Collection Report for July 2017 was presented and accepted upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by T. Moyer. The motion passed unanimously.

Councilman M. Bullick made a motion seconded by A. Metricarti to purchase a new 2017 Ram 1500 SSV Police 4x4 pickup truck with crew cab in the amount of \$31,735.00. The truck will be purchased at New Holland Auto Group under the Costars Agreement. The motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Guest read a letter from Mr. Andy Hoff that was enclosed with a check in the amount of \$350.00 for police equipment, and thanked the police for their service to the community.

Mayor Guest informed Council that he received a check in the amount of \$10,000 to be used to outfit the new police vehicle. The donation was from a local business who wishes to remain anonymous. A motion was made by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti to accept the donations. The motion passed unanimously.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT & COMMUNICATIONS:

Manager Leonard presented Resolution #2017-15 authorizing the entry of the borough into a Master Lease Agreement with Fulton Bank for the 2017 Ram 1500 SSV Police Truck. Motion by J. Moskal seconded by T. Weikel to accept Resolution #2017-15. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard presented Council with bid tabulations for the Main Street crosswalk. There were two bids received for the project: Carr & Duff - \$181,456.75 and Telco \$211,221.71. Motion by T. Weikel seconded by M. Bullick to accept the lowest bid from Carr and Duff in the amount of \$181,456.75. Motion passed unanimously. There is a Multimodal Grant for this project in the amount of \$121,529.00.

Manager Leonard presented to Council Resolution #2017-14 to adopt a temporary two- hour parking limit between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 4 P.M. daily in the borough parking lot located between 308 and 320 Main Street. Motion by M. Bullick seconded by T. Moyer to adopt Resolution #2017-14. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard informed Council that the water issue at 6th and Arch Street has been temporarily repaired thanks to Craig Keffer and the streets department.

Manager Leonard informed Council that South Sixth Avenue paving project was completed.

Manager Leonard discussed buying an ice skating rink for the children of the borough. There was a discussion with Council and it was asked to be directed to the Park and Recreation Committee.

FINANCE COMMITTEE:

Disbursements in the amount of \$178,345.44 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by M. Stehman. Motion passed unanimously.

T. Weikel stated that the budget meeting for department heads will be on September 19, 2017 at 7 P.M.

WASTE WATER COMMITTEE:

The report of the Waste Water Treatment Plant Superintendent for the month of July 2017 was presented and accepted upon motion of M. Stehman seconded by M. Bullick. The motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE:

The report of the Director of Public Works for the month of July was presented and accepted upon motion of J. Moskal seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

The report of the Code Enforcement Officer for the month of July 2017 was presented and accepted upon motion by J. Moskal seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

PARK & RECREATION COMMITTEE:

T. Moyer reported that there is a shredding event at Victory Park on September 16, 2017 from 10 A.M. to noon.

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE:

The report of the Chief of Police for the month of July 2017 was presented and accepted upon motion by M. Bullick seconded by M. Stehman. The motion passed unanimously.

M. Bullick asked permission from Council to put the old police radios on Municibid. Motion by M. Bullick seconded by M. Stehman. Motion passed unanimously.

The report of the Borough Fire Chief for the month of July 2017 was presented and accepted upon motion by M. Bullick seconded by T. Moyer. Motion passed unanimously.

President A. Dham appointed M. Stehman and T. Weikel to interview the sewer engineers and M. Bullick and A. Metricarti to interview the borough engineers. Borough Council decided to put an RFP out for a sewer engineer and borough engineer to see their options.

MAYOR:

Mayor Guest read a letter from Sacred Heart Church thanking the police for their services during the annual fair in July.

ADJOURNMENT:

The meeting was adjourned at 7:51 P.M. upon a motion by T. Weikel seconded by M. Stehman. The motion passed unanimously.
