The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by President Anil Dham at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT:

Solicitor R. Brant reported he has a proposed Ordinance #896 regarding parking ticket increases to be advertised. Motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti. The motion passed unanimously.

VISITORS:

Sue Grove from Adams Street thanked the committee for their hard work on Community Day.

Approval of the meeting minutes for August 14 and the amended minutes of August 28, 2018. Motion to approve the minutes by T. Weikel seconded by T. Moyer. Motion passed unanimously.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT:

Manager Leonard reported that the Borough needs a motion for Resolution #2018-16 allowing the Borough to apply for a grant from the Pennsylvania Gaming Local Share Account (LSA) not to exceed \$500,000 from the Commonwealth Financing Authority to be used for wastewater infrastructure. Motion to pass Resolution #2018-16 by T. Weikel seconded by M. Stehman. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard presented to Council the pension 2019 Minimum Municipal Obligation (MMO) for the Police and Non –Uniform employees. The obligation for the Police Department is \$99, 335.00 and for the Non Uniform employees \$34,143.00. Motion to approve the MMO report by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

FINANCE COMMITTEE:

Disbursements in the amount of \$160,253.30 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by M. Stehman. The motion passed unanimously.

PLANNING COMMISSION:

President A. Dham reported that there will be a Planning Commission meeting on Monday September 10, 2018 to hear a land development project from Unifirst/Unitech, located at 401 North 3rd Avenue. The project was approved subject to two conditions; whatever EDU requirements that are needed, and to educate the public regarding their company.

MSC is the leasing company for the former Lebow building and former McKissic building. The leasing company attended Community Day and also had a box for suggestions regarding what people would like to see on Main Street.

The Borough will be amending the grant for the railroad trestle bridge moving from recreation to transportation.

MAYOR:

Mayor Antoniewicz wanted to thank the Public Works, Fire Company, EMS, Police Department, and dedicated volunteers and especially Amy Demchik for all the work on Community Day.

Mayor Antoniewicz informed Council that Fire, EMS, Police, and Emergency Management will be holding an Emergency Management Resource Fair on the evening of October 10 from 5 PM to 8 PM at the fire company.

Mayor Antoniewicz reported that the Montgomery County LGBT Business Council had a fundraiser/recognition event recognizing the municipalities who passed the Anti-Discrimination Ordinance.

Mayor Antoniewicz reported that she is working on mental health workshops.
