The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by President Anil Dham at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

VISITORS:

No visitors spoke at the meeting.

The Treasurer's Report and Sewer & Solid Waste Collection Report for October 2018 was presented and accepted upon motion by T. Weikel seconded A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT:

Manager Leonard reported that the borough received a DCNR Grant for the trail on the north side of Main Street in the amount of \$280,000.

Manager Leonard reported on the boat dock and informed Council that the insurance company has been notified of the damaged dock.

Manager Leonard reported to Council on the take back of Main Street and Second Avenue. The project will go before the State Workers Union for approval to allow the borough to take back Main Street and Second Avenue on December 12, 2018.

Manager Leonard reported to Council that Phase 1 Environmental Study was completed on the lot at 4th and Main Street.

FINANCE COMMITTEE:

Disbursements in the amount of \$81,432.59 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti. The motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE/CODE ENFORCEMENT:

The report of the Director of Public Works for the month of October 2018 was presented and accepted upon motion by A. Demchik seconded by T. Weikel. The motion passed unanimously.

A. Demchik reported on the tree lighting being a success. There is a Santa mailbox next to the flag pole on Main Street for children to send letters to Santa. A generous donation from the Royersford Bocce Club was received for the tree lighting.

A. Metricarti stated that the parking committee met on Monday November 26, 2018 and there will be a report on the findings and suggestions of the committee.

Mayor Antoniewicz reported that a resident wants to talk about bike lanes in the borough.
