

May 28, 2019

The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by President Anil Dham at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

Present: A. Demchik, A. Dham, A. Metricarti, J. Moskal, T. Moyer, M. Stehman, T. Weikel, Mayor J. Antoniewicz, and D. Ziegler

**VISITORS:**

No visitors spoke at the meeting.

The students of Oak Elementary School gave a presentation on recycling.

The Treasurer Report and Sewer & Solid Waste Collection Report for April 2019 was presented and accepted upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by M. Stehman. Motion passed unanimously.

A. Metricarti asked if the borough had a way to automatically withdraw the sewer/trash bills directly from the resident's bank account. D. Ziegler stated the new software does support that process and she would look into it.

**BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT:**

Resolution No. 2019-07 was presented requesting permission to apply for a Greenways, Trails and Recreation Program Grant of \$125,000 from Commonwealth Financing Authority to be used for Victory Park ADA and playground improvements, designating Manager Michael A. Leonard and Council President Anil Dham to execute all documents and agreements. Motion by T. Weikel seconded by T. Moyer to approve Resolution No. 2019-07. Motion passed unanimously.

The Borough will be receiving a \$125,000 grant from Montgomery County 2040 Program for phase 4 of the river trail (the north side of Main Street).

**FINANCE COMMITTEE:**

Disbursements in the amount of \$98,395.31 were presented and accepted and authorized paid upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by M. Stehman. Motion passed unanimously.

**WASTE WATER COMMITTEE:**

The report of the Waste Water Treatment Plant Superintendent for the month of April was presented and accepted upon motion of M. Stehman seconded by J. Moskal. The motion passed unanimously.

**PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE:**

The report of the Director of Public Works for the month of April was presented and accepted upon motion of A. Demchik seconded by A. Metricarti. The motion passed unanimously.

The report of the Code Enforcement Officer for the month of April was presented and accepted upon motion by A. Demchik seconded by T. Weikel. The motion passed unanimously.

**PARK & RECREATION COMMITTEE:**

The minutes of the May 2, 2019 committee meeting were presented and accepted upon motion by T. Moyer seconded by A. Metricarti. The motion passed unanimously.

**PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE:**

The report of the Chief of Police for the month of April was presented and accepted upon a motion by J. Moskal seconded by A. Metricarti. The motion passed unanimously.

The report of the Borough Fire Marshal for the month of April 2019 was presented and accepted upon motion by J. Moskal seconded by T. Weikel. The motion passed unanimously.

The report of the Royersford Fire Chief for the month of April was presented and accepted upon a motion by J. Moskal seconded by T. Weikel. The motion passed unanimously.

J. Moskal stated there were 11 foot patrols and 19 speed details completed by the Police Department.

**PLANNING COMMISSION:** No report

President Dham advised Council that the police management study is going well and should be completed in July.

President Dham reminded Council of the sojourn arriving on June 5<sup>th</sup> around noon.

President Dham commented on the good turnout and support Sweet Aloha received at their grand opening from Royersford and surrounding towns.

**MAYOR:**

Mayor Antoniewicz thanked the VFW, police, fire, boy scouts, and SF Middle School band for attending the Memorial Day Parade.

Mayor Antoniewicz announced upcoming fundraisers to benefit “National Night Out.”
