PFM Financial Advisors- Scott Shearer and Tom Wyatt from the Law Office of Obermayer spoke to Borough Council regarding the sale of the wastewater plant. There were questions regarding our current workers at the wastewater plant and if their position is stable with a new company. Their answer was the new company, whoever they are, like to keep the people who know the operation of the plant.
