

October 8, 2019

The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by President Anil Dham at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

Present: A. Demchik, A. Dham, A. Metricarti, J. Moskal, T. Moyer, M. Stehman, T. Weikel, Mayor J. Antoniewicz, Solicitor R. Brant, and Manager M. Leonard

VISITORS:

Paul Chrisman, 750 Main Street stated that the Treasurer's Report is not attached to the minutes on the website. Manager Leonard stated that he will make the correction. Mr. Chrisman wanted to compliment the borough on all the grants they received and asked how much matching grant money in the 2019 budget was used. Manager stated all the matching money was used along with some capital reserve money.

Motion by T. Weikel seconded by T. Moyer to approve the meeting minutes for September 10 & September 24, 2019. Motion passed unanimously.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT:

Solicitor Brant reported that swap number one which is the land for the Veterans Memorial should be settling in about a week.

Solicitor Brant held a public hearing on Ordinance #901 amending the Pension Ordinance #829 in part that changes a portion of the Non Uniform Pension Plan. Motion by T. Weikel seconded by T. Moyer by roll call. Ms. Demchik-yes, Mr. Dham-yes, Ms. Metricarti-yes, Mr. Moskal-yes, Ms. Moyer- yes, Mr. Stehman-yes, Mr. Weikel-yes. Motion passed 7-0.

Solicitor Brant informed Council that PFM will attend our November12th Council meeting to discuss the sewer plant bids.

Solicitor Brant asked Council members for an executive session to discuss personnel issues. Council went into executive session.

Council went back into regular session.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT:

Manager Leonard updated Council on the paving of Main Street from 5th Avenue to the foot of the bridge. Proposed completed date is October 9, 2019.

Manager Leonard reported that the lot at 4th Avenue and Main Street is moving along contractor will be starting after Halloween.

Manager Leonard updated Council on the water problem at 320 Main Street. The street department completed the project and saved the Borough money. Thanks to all the members of the public works department.

Manager Leonard stated that the CDBG Grant for twenty eight handicap ramps on different parts of town will start on October 14, 2019.

Manager Leonard asked Council if they would approve a change order for porous macadam mix so that the parking lot at 4th & Main will drain into the ground and not over flow our drainage system. The total cost of the change order is \$3,300.00. Motion by T. Moyer second by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

There was a discussion regarding how the Borough would collect the money and how the trash bills would be sent out.

Manager Leonard presented a resignation from Sharon Romer, Tax Collector effective December 31, 2019. Motion to accept Sharon Romer's resignation by A. Metricarti seconded by T. Weikel. Motion passed unanimously Council thanked her for her service.

FINANCE COMMITTEE:

Disbursements in the amount of \$358,931.38 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by M. Stehman. Motion passed unanimously.

General Code sent the codes to be reviewed by the committee T. Weikel, J. Moskal, and A. Dham.
