The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by President Anil Dham at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

VISITORS:

No visitors wished to speak at the meeting.

President Dham presented a plaque to Sharon Romer for her many years of service as tax collector. Sharon will resign as tax collector as of December 31, 2019.

President Dham presented a plaque to William Brunner for his long service to the Historical Society and the hard work on providing all the pictures for the Borough calendar.

The Treasurers Report and Sewer & Solid Waste Collection Report for October 2019 was presented and accepted upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by M. Stehman. Motion passed unanimously.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT:

Manager Leonard informed Council that trash pickup and recycling will be picked up on both the north side and the south side on Tuesday. No more trash pickup on Monday.

Manager Leonard informed Council that the meeting on April 28, 2020 needs to be changed due to Election Day. It was the consensus of Council to move the meeting to April 27, 2020. Manager Leonard stated he will now advertise the meeting dates in the newspaper.

Manager Leonard informed Council that the police truck has been totaled and he is working with the insurance company.

Manager Leonard recommended to Council that we keep the parking lot closed at 4th & Main until it gets paved in the spring; Council agreed.

FINANCE COMMITTEE:

Disbursements in the amount of \$434,855.29 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

T. Weikel presented the 2020 proposed budget to Borough Council letting them know how they arrived at a .75 mill tax increase. T. Weikel made a motion seconded by A. Metricarti to advertise the 2020 budget for 10 days for public viewing. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti to advertise the tax ordinance for 2020. Motion passed unanimously.

WASTE WATER COMMITTEE:

The report of the Waste Water Treatment Plant Superintendent for the month of October 2019 was presented and accepted upon motion of M. Stehman seconded by T. Weikel. Motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE/CODE ENFORCEMENT:

The report of the Director of Public Works for the month of October 2019 was presented and accepted upon motion of A. Demchik seconded by M. Stehman. Motion passed unanimously.

The report of the Code Enforcement Officer for the month of October 2019 was presented and accepted upon motion by A. Demchik seconded by T. Moyer. Motion passed unanimously.

A. Demchik reported the tree lighting is scheduled for November 29, 2019 at 6 PM. Santa arrives at 7 PM.
