

Reorganization Meeting
January 6, 2020

The reorganization meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7 P.M. by Mayor Jenna Antoniewicz at Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

Roll call was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Present: Amy Demchik, Anil Dham, Alex Metricarti, Joseph Moskal, Tiffany Moyer, Matt Stehman, Mayor Jenna Antoniewicz, and Manager Michael A. Leonard

Tiffany Moyer and Joseph Moskal took the Oath of office from Mayor Jenna Antoniewicz.

Mayor Jenna Antoniewicz read the resignation of Kim Kirschner. It is with regret that I will not be taking my elected seat on Council due to recent health and family issues. I appreciate the opportunity and fully support Council and their efforts to revitalize Royersford this year and beyond. Motion by Anil Dham seconded by Alex Metricarti to accept the resignation with regret. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Jenna Antoniewicz requested nominations for President of Borough Council. Matt Stehman nominated Anil Dham seconded by Tiffany Moyer, with no other nomination for Council President. The motion to elect Anil Dham was unanimous.

President Anil Dham requested nomination for Vice President of Borough Council Alex Metricarti nominated Matt Stehman for Vice President seconded by Tiffany Moyer with no other nomination for Vice President. A motion to elect Matt Stehman Vice President was unanimous.

President Dham requested nomination for Council Pro Tem of Royersford Council. Matt Stehman nominated Alex Metricarti seconded by Tiffany Moyer, with no other nomination for Council Pro Tem. A motion to elect Alex Metricarti was unanimous.

Manager Leonard presented Resolution 2020-01 Tax Anticipation Loan from Victory Bank in the amount of \$400,000 to be paid back by December 31, 2020. The loan will be filed with the Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED). Motion by A. Metricarti seconded by M. Stehman. Motion passed unanimously.

A. Metricarti informed Council that Jackie Wagner, after 26 years, is resigning from the Park and Recreation Committee. Motion by A. Metricarti seconded by M. Stehman to accept the resignation with regret. Motion passed unanimously.

A. Metricarti would like to reappoint Nancy Kupferschmidt and Shannon Cucchi for a 3 year term to the Park and Recreation Committee with the term expiring on December 31, 2022. Motion by A. Metricarti seconded by T. Moyer. Motion passed with one objection by M. Stehman.

A. Metricarti nominated Tamara Sim 640 Elm Street seconded by Amy Demchik to serve a 3 year term on the Park and Recreation Committee the term expires on December 31, 2022. Motion passed unanimously.

A. Metricarti would like to make a motion seconded by A. Demchik to appoint Terence Wiand of 371 Green Street to a 3 year term on the Planning Commission. Motion passed unanimously.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:15PM by motion of M. Stehman seconded A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.
