The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by President Anil Dham at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

**VISITORS:**

Paul Chrisman 750 Main Street wanted to publicly thank Donna Ziegler for having the trash truck go back and pick up 3 bags of leaves at Mr. Chrisman's curb that the trash truck left behind.

Last week Council voted to approve a four hundred thousand dollar tax anticipation loan, that indicated that Council is spending more money than they are taking in and Mr. Chrisman is concerned for the tax payers of Royersford Borough.

The meeting minutes of the December 10, 2019 were approved as distributed upon a motion by M. Stehman seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

**BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT:**

Manager Leonard provided Borough Council with a copy of Resolution 2020-02 Application for Traffic Signal Approval from Penn Dot for the push button light at 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Main Street. Motion to approve Resolution 2020-02 by A. Metricarti seconded by M. Stehman. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard informed Council he received a letter from Ashwin B. Patel from Penn Dot on December 17, 2019 regarding the additional traffic light at the railroad tracks. Motion by M. Stehman seconded by J. Moskal that the Borough is not interested in changing the traffic light and doing anything regarding the traffic light.

Manager Leonard informed Council that the Police Department requested to replace the pickup truck that was totaled and purchase a new 2020 pickup truck cost \$28,952.00. Motion by J. Moskal seconded by M. Stehman that the Borough purchase the 2020 pickup truck only after the manager is provided a formal written quote from the dealership. Motion passed unanimously.

Disbursements in the amount of \$287,808.07 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by A. Metricarti seconded by T. Moyer Motion passed unanimously.
