

March 10, 2020

The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by President Anil Dham at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

Present: A. Demchik, A. Dham, A. Metricarti, J. Moskal, T. Moyer, M. Stehman, T. Weikel, Mayor J. Antoniewicz, Solicitor R. Brant, and Manager M. Leonard

VISITORS:

No visitors spoke at the meeting.

SOLICITOR REPORT:

Solicitor Brant reviewed the ordinance for the Riverfront Development Overlay; he recommended that the Montgomery County Planning Commission and the Borough Planning Commission give recommendation before we advertise the ordinance. A. Metricarti asked is there a difference between how a Township and a Borough handle the ordinance, Solicitor Brant answered no. T. Moyer asked what the height restriction in the ordinance is, the answer is 65 feet. The trail in the development will be able to handle emergency equipment.

Solicitor Brant is looking into 301 Walnut Street regarding the zoning requirements. There has been no movement on the property to make it a brew pub. The agreement for a trash container from the Borough will be looked at also.

The minutes of the February 11 and February 25, 2020 meetings were approved as distributed upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT:

Manager Leonard presented Council with the final parking lot signs. Motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti to give Craig Keffer, Public Works Director, permission to purchase the parking lot signs. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard stated that the 2020 Liquid Fuels allotment was \$128,557.61. Motion to accept the allotment by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard researched property deeds on what was called Maple Street. It has been determined that the two property owners one on the right and left on what was called Maple Street own to the middle of the street, so it is concluded that a portion of Maple Street was turned over to the property owners years ago. That should resolve the issue.

Manager Leonard sent Council a letter he received from Kimberton Waldorf School thanking Craig Keffer and his crew for delivering leaves to help with the schools garden.

FINANCE COMMITTEE:

Disbursements in the amount of \$197,167.01 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

T. Weikel would like to thank Chris Chrisman for finding the errors in the new codes. The Planning Commissions both Montgomery County and Royersford Borough need to review the codes before we advertise for codification.

Mayor Antoniewicz reported that the Police fundraiser made \$1,100.00 at Stickman Brews.


Mayor Antoniewicz reported to Council that she will be performing a wedding on October 3, 2020.
