The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 pm by President Anil Dham at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

Absent: M. Stehman and Mayor J. Antoniewicz

#### VISITORS:

Paul Chrisman 750 Main Street addressed Council and asked when the tax anticipation loan will be paid back and how much was spent to date. Manager Leonard stated that the loan has to be paid back by the end of the year and we spent to date around \$200,000.

Julie Lacey Chairperson of Park & Recreation was contacted by some residents in Royersford Borough and asked Council if it would be possible to put in a pickle ball court somewhere in the Borough.

#### SOLICITOR'S REPORT:

Solicitor B. Dunbar held a public hearing for Ordinance No. 904 regarding an ordinance codification for the Borough of Royersford. Solicitor Dunbar opened the public hearing with no comments or questions from the public. He asked Council if they had any questions, there were none. Motion to approve Ordinance No. 904 by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti by roll call vote. Ms. Demchik-yes, Mr. Dham-yes, Ms. Metricarti-yes, Mr. Moskal-yes, Ms. Moyer-yes, Mr. Weikel-yes. Motion was passed 6 yes-0 no. M. Stehman was absent.

Solicitor B. Dunbar held a public hearing for Ordinance No. 905 amending Chapter 27 Zoning Ordinance regarding signs and definitions of manufactured homes. Solicitor Dunbar opened the hearing to the public and asked the public and Council if there were any questions, there were none. Motion to approve Ordinance No. 905 by T. Weikel seconded by J. Moskal by roll call vote. Ms. Demchik-yes, Mr. Dham-yes, Ms. Metricarti-yes, Mr. Moskal-yes, Ms. Moyer-yes, Mr. Weikel-yes. Motion passed 6-0. M. Stehman was absent.

#### MANAGER'S REPORT:

Manager Leonard updated Council on all the road construction in the Borough.

Manager Leonard presented Resolution #2020-11 giving permission to Manager Michael A. Leonard to sign the police truck loan documents. Motion by T. Moyer seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard stated that he thinks the boat dock is not repairable. The insurance company was called and we are assessing the damage. The Hill School has been informed.

Manager Leonard informed Council that he met with the Veterans and the memorial project is moving forward.

**FINANCE COMMITTEE:**

Disbursements in the amount of \$225,803.85 were presented and authorized to be paid upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti. The motion passed unanimously.

T. Moyer reported that there will be a shredding event on September 19, 2020.

**PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE:**

**PERSONNEL COMMITTEE:**

Denise Cranata and Jennifer Kampmann tendered their resignation from the Park and Recreation Commission. Motion by A. Metricarti seconded by T. Weikel to accept the two resignations. Motion passed unanimously.

**PLANNING COMMISSION:**


A. Dham welcomed a new business, Uncommon Exchange that opened Sunday August 9, 2020.
