 7:30 pm Borough Hall



Environmental Commission (Combined with Woolwich, May 2013)

The commission is established for the protection, development or use of natural resources including water sources located within the territorial limits of the Borough of Swedesboro.

A Joint Environmental Commission shall consist of 10 members plus two alternates. The Mayor of Woolwich Township shall appoint five members, one of whom shall also be a member of the joint Land Use Board, plus one alternate and all of whom shall be residents of the Township of Woolwich. The Mayor of the Borough of Swedesboro shall appoint five members, one of whom shall also be on the Joint Land Use Board, plus one alternate and all of whom shall be residents of the Borough of Swedesboro. The members shall serve without compensation except as hereinafter provided. The Swedesboro-Woolwich Joint Environmental Commission shall elect one of its members to serve as Chairman and presiding officer of the Joint Commission. The term of the Chairman shall be for one year. The terms of office of the first Commissioners shall be for one, two or three years, to be designated by the Mayors in making their appointments and their successors shall be appointed for terms of three years and until appointment and qualification of successor. The alternates shall be appointed for one year. (End of Term is noted). The meetings will be held at 7:00 p.m., the second Thursday of every month. The site for these meetings will alternate monthly between the Swedesboro Borough and Woolwich Township Municipal buildings.

Business Development Advisory Committee
