4. New Business

A. 2016 Year End Report

Overall, the number of cases in 2016 was average in number, but there has been an uptick of larger cases that require investigation including Battery, Domestic Disturbance, Drugs (Including Traffic) Fraud/Forgery, Sexual Assault, Theft/Burglary, and Trouble with Party including homeless. In all, 1,043 cases were opened in 2016, supporting the need to hire the additional police officer.

The report also covered police vehicle maintenance performed in 2016. Maintenance was standard in nature including: oil changes, tire rotations, brake pad replacement and rotors for one vehicle, one realignment, one ball joint replacement, and two nails in tires.

B. Consideration of the 2017 Occupational Health Service Agreement
