Chairman Naccarato called the special meeting to order at 6 PM.

The purpose of the meeting was to consider public comments and resolutions pertaining to the Ulster County Law Enforcement Center.

The first resolution was authorizing the County to acquire the Rahl property pursuant to Eminent Domain Procedure Law. The authorization is based on the findings and determinations as required in the Statute and the Negative Declaration previously adopted under SEQ. Motion moved by Leg. Wilkins, seconded by Leg. Hathaway. Leg. Dart and Feldmann voted against measure.

The second resolution was for adopting a second Negative Declaration in accordance with SEQ requirement to address modifications in the proposed Law Enforcement Center as a result of detailed designs now available. Motion moved by Leg. Dart, seconded by Leg. Wilkins. Motion carried.

Leg. Dart inquired what the offer was for the acquisition of John Rahl's property. Marc Phelan informed the committee that the price of the property was \$70,000.

There were no members from the public who wished to address the committee. There being no further business to conduct, the meeting adjourned at 6:07 pm.
