I. STOP DWI

Mary McMickle presented the agenda.

Mary introduced a resolution amending the 1999 Ulster County Budget, in the amount of \$32,667.00 Transfer from Ulster County STOP-DWI General Fund A10009760000 to STOP DWI Equipment to A419152035000.

This will allow for the additional purchase of equipment ( i.e. five datamasters; four alco-sensors; one large TV for the Legislature Chambers) to be used by local police agencies, Sheriff's Office, Probation Dept and DWI Impact Panel. Moved by Legislator Bertone, seconded by Legislator Busick. Unanimously carried. (Legislators Felicello, Gerentine, Busick, Every, Lent, Roberti, Bertone, Smith, Magarelli all in favor)

STOP DWI sponsored a training for all police agencies that have already received the new datamasters.

The 16th Annual Mid-Hudson Region STOP DWI Coordinators Enforcement Prosecution, hosted by Ulster County STOP DWI will be held at the Nevele Grande March 4th and 5th. Approximately 200 people will be attending from New York State.

Diane Johnson presented the agenda.

Air Quality review has been taken at Social Services Building. The roofs have been replaced on the Mental Health Building and Resnick Building.

Fire and Safety Inspections have been taken in all county buildings.
