A brief presentation was given by Terry Pinnix of Aramark Correctional Service and Lori Schroeder, District Manager for the food service. They would like to take over the kitchen facility in the Jail and be responsible for feeding all inmates and personnel. That could save the County \$100,000 a year. They also will put the County's employees on their payroll or the County could keep them as they are and the company will manage them. The Sheriff will obtain exact figures for 1996 as to what it would cost and how much the County would save. Aramark would deal with local vendors in buying food, if possible, such as local apples and corn from county farmers. The price of a meal could range from \$1.65 to \$1.75. They presently service 120 facilities in 28 states. Local counties they now serve are Westchester, Orange and Monroe Counties.

Also present for this presentation was Daniel Alfonso, Chairman of the Legislature, Philip Sinagra, Majority Leader, Undersheriff Richard Bockelmann and Sheriff Michael LaPaglia to ask questions.

Sheriff LaPaglia presented a resolution in the amount of \$38,700 to purchase three new vehicles for the Detective and Civil Division. No action was taken. Money was put in the 1996 budget for these items.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 7:40 P.M.
