Karsten, Arson Task Force

Charlene Cappillino of Alternative Sentencing explained her budget and the need for a new van to transport weekenders. The present van has over 200,000 miles on it and is no longer safe.

Charles Karsten, representing Kenneth Blundell of the Arson Task Force, asked for a resolution to amend the Ulster County Arson Task Force Project Plan. The resolution was moved by Legislator Hathaway and seconded by Legislator Contini.

Undersheriff Richard Bockelmann asked that the Committee act on the following resolutions:

1. Request to transfer \$54,000 into the Ulster County Sheriff's Department Jail Divisions budget line item AA-A-3150-0-4400, Contractual Expenses from Contingency. Motion moved by Legislator Tantillo, seconded by Legislator Hathaway.
2. Request to transfer \$40,000 into the Sheriff's Jail Division Part-time line item AA-A-3150-0-1995 from Contingency. Motion made by Legislator Felicello, seconded by Legislator Tantillo.

3. Request to transfer \$501.50 into the Public Service Part-time line item AA-A-3110-0-1988 from the Part-time Deputies line. Motion made by Legislator Tantillo, seconded by Legislator Contini.
4. Request to transfer \$4,800 into the Security Services Courts Overtime line item AA-A-1115-0-1997 from personnel line items. Motion made by Legislator Loughran, seconded by Legislator Contini.
5. Request to transfer \$10,434 into employees terminated line item AA-A-3110-0-1996 from a personnel line item. Motion made by Legislator O'Reilly, seconded by Legislator Tantillo.
6. Request to transfer \$6,500 from the appropriated fund balance GA-A-5110 to the Sheriff's Drug Investigations Account AA-A-3189-0-1997 to replenish the Sheriff's Office narcotics over-time line for purposes of continuing drug investigations in Ulster County. Motion made by Legislator Felicello, seconded by Legislator Hathaway.
7. Request to transfer \$47,800 into the Sheriff's 3110 over-time line item 3110-0-1997 from personnel line items, with the balance being procured from contingency. Motion made by Legislator Hathaway, seconded by Legislator O'Reilly.
8. Request to transfer \$88,600 into the Ulster County Sheriff's Department Jail Division's budget line item AA-A-3150-0-1997 Overtime from vacant personnel salary line items. Motion made by Legislator Contini, seconded by Legislator Tantillo.

Legislator O'Reilly asked Chairman Naccarato to check and see if the Sheriff's Department received the money promised from the Woodstock Festival.

There being no further business, on motion made by Legislator Tantillo and seconded by Legislator O'Reilly, the meeting was adjourned at 7:20 P.M.
