It was noted that there are no funds remaining in the District Attorney's following budget lines:

Item 4200	- Telephone	\$ 2,000
Item 4400	- Miscellaneous	20,000
Item 4560	- Witness Expenses	5,000
Item 4630	- Investigations	5,000
Item 4655	- Mileage Expense	2,000

Chairman Naccarato asked if the money could be taken out of any other place in his budget, and Mr. Kavanagh responded no. There is a major investigation in the courts before the end of the year and this will affect telephone expenses and witness expenses. The total amount needed is \$34,000 to the end of the year.

A resolution was not acted upon due to no quorum present.

Legislator Carle asked if Sheriff LaPaglia could help with forfeiture money from drug funds. Chairman Naccarato said he would ask the Sheriff if it would be possible to help.

The meeting adjourned at 6:45 P.M.
