Mitch Manzo of EMC presented resolutions that are already in Albany. Next he presented NY Senate Bill 7789 and HR 4916 and there was discussion. It was indicated that neither bill is strong enough. There are three toxic sites in Ulster County untouched.

Legislator Roberts, who was appointed by NYSAC, asked that solid waste alternates be looked at. Legislator Bischoff offered the idea of bringing in people from EPA and DEC, along with neighboring counties.

Jay Martin of Federated Sportsman noted that each club got 85 birds. More clubs are looking to join. He also indicated that Wayne Elliot of DEC spoke at the water release in Esopus. Water temperatures are important.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 7:50 P.M.
