Art Snyder, Director of Emergency Management Control, gave his monthly report and what took place during the recent storm/blizzard. He noted there might be money to cover some of the costs of the Highway Department which may be obtained under a Federal Funds Emergency Declaration. Flooding could occur any day if the area gets a lot of rain.

Regarding the jail, Legislator O'Reilly asked who will be in charge of this project after the Committee makes its recommendation. Chairman Naccarato answered that Legislative Chairman Benjamin will be the person to make the final decision on this matter.
