Maureen Radl, representing UFO (Ulsterites Fight Overflights), spoke in favor of the committee voting on a proposed resolution affecting flights into New York City airports.

On a motion by Legislator Bischoff, seconded by Legislator Baker and unanimously passed, the Committee adopted the following resolution: Urging the Federal Aviation Administration to Make More Use of Ocean Airspace in the Routing of Aircraft Departures From New York-New Jersey Metropolitan Area Airports and Recommending to Ulster County's State and Federal Representatives That They Urge the Same.

Lorraine Fiore, representing the Soil and Water District, reported on her agency's activities.

Legislator Schneller, a member of the Forest Practice Board, reported that he would be meeting tomorrow with DEP, DEC, landowners, foresters and others on matters relating to timber harvesting in the New York City watershed area.

Cary MacDonald, EMC, reported on the fall road maintenance seminar being sponsored by the County and New York City DEP.

Ms. MacDonald also stated that the EMC will not be a party to the lawsuit recently filed by EMC Chairman Kim Massie against the Town of Rochester.

On a motion by Legislator Bischoff, seconded by Legislator Alfonso, and all in favor, the following resolution was adopted by the Committee: A Resolution Establishing a Program Whereby Solid Waste Generated by Ulster County Municipal Operations Would Be Separated, Collected, and Hauled to the Relevant Solid Waste Transfer Stations by Equipment Controlled and Operated by Ulster County; hereafter termed "Self-hauling".

After a brief discussion on the proposed amended "Regulation For Administration and Management of the Wild, Scenic and Recreational Rivers System of New York State", no action was taken.

The meeting adjourned at 7:48 P.M.
