Cary MacDonald of EMC gave a report which consisted of: Kim Massie's letter to Chairman Irwin regarding sponsoring an animal rights forum; NYS A.9652/Bragman resolution concerning clean air which the EMC strongly opposes; EMC passage of a resolution supporting packaging legislation; Environmental Trust Act.

Charles Shaw of the RRA reported on the landfill consolidation plan which the DEC must now approve; the municipal solid waste agreements; Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Law rules and regulations. A public hearing has been set to discuss changes after which this Committee will review modifications. Mr. Shaw also reported on modifications to the Solid Waste Management Law (Flow Control legislation) rules and regulations on which a public hearing has been set; the

RRA's passage of Resolution #211 "Conceptual Approval of Landfill Closure Assistance Program and Authorization to Conduct a Public Participation Process Thereon".

The Consumer Fraud Bureau report from Jonathan Van Vlack focused on: establishing a public hearing on an Introductory Local Law concerning checkout accuracy. An informational meeting will be set up for the fall. The report also mentioned the Youth Bureau and Consumer Affairs' jointly sponsored consumer questions contest at youth centers and the compilation of town door-to-door peddler ordinances.

There was no Federated Sportsmen report.
