Kenneth Blundell, Chairman of the Arson Task Force, gave a report on the van. The Committee asked Mr. Blundell to check with BOCES to see if they can do it as a project or should the Committee submit a resolution. He will obtain the information by December 15.

Sheriff Michael LaPaglia requested a transfer of \$1,546 from line item drug forfeiture expenses to overtime line item. A motion was made by Legislator Contini and seconded by Legislator Baumgarten.

A motion was made by Legislator Contini and seconded by Legislator Felicello to transfer a total of \$4,500 to cover the salary of a Corrections Officer promotion.

Sheriff LaPaglia also requested to have his outerwear as soon as possible since it is costing the County \$1,200 to board out the prisoners.

Max Reiderer, Director of the Emergency Management Office gave his monthly report, which included the chemical spill in New Paltz, public service announcement and the Benedictine Hospital report. He noted that Ruth Siegal, the Assistant Director, will be leaving this month and the position will not be filled.

Duncan Wilson, Chief Fire Coordinator, gave his monthly report.

Barbara Patrick of the Town of Esopus spoke to the Committee about the abuse of animals in Ulster County.
