The meeting was called to order by Chairman Tipp at 6:00 P.M.

Lucy Honig, Human Relations Commission, reported on the Fair Practice Sexual Orientation Public Hearing and proposed legislation. Discussion ensued on this topic and on the proposed budget for 1993. 84 complaints have been received by this office since January 1992. 9 complaints have been sent to the State Division for Human Relations, 6 have yet to be prepared to go to the State and there are 6 active investigations currently in progress.

Alice White, Youth Bureau, presented a resolution to amend the Youth Bureau 1992 Budget to reflect a \$500. increase in state aid for contractual expenses. Legislator Cummings moved to accept the resolution and Legislator Baumgarten seconded.

Patricia P. Pine, Office for the Aging, gave a report on the activities of the office. A copy of the business study conducted by Information Services was distributed to members of the committee. Discussion on the possible bus acquisition ensued.

As there was no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:05 p.m.
