Patricia P. Pine gave a report on the activities of the Office for the Aging. There was some discussion on the joint application of the Sullivan and Ulster County Offices for the Aging for an SSI outreach grant designed to find senior citizens who are eligible for SSI and get them enrolled.

Alice White, Youth Bureau, presented the 3 year comprehensive plan and an accompanying resolution allowing the Chairman of the Legislature to enter into contract with the state to receive an anticipated allocation to the county of \$461,654. Legislator Pecora moved to accept the resolution and Legislator Baumgarten seconded.

A written report from Lucy Honig, Director of the Human Relations Commission was distributed. All were reminded that the Public Hearing for local fair practices/sexual orientation legislation would take place on July 2nd at 7:00 p.m. at the Ulster BOCES Conference Center in New Paltz.

There being no further business, Legislator Fall moved to adjourn. This was seconded by Legislator Provenzano. The meeting was adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
