Charles Shaw, Executive Director of the Resource Recovery Agency, along with Manna Jo Greene, Charles Entress and Stephen Wing of the RRA, answered questions and proposed changes as outlined in an October 28 memo from Stephen Wing to Charles Shaw.

An amendment to Section 6h was moved by Legislator Hall, seconded by Legislator McCaig and defeated by a vote of 2-4.

An amendment to Section 7 to include household batteries as a regulated recyclable was moved by Legislator Hall, seconded by Legislator Alfonso and defeated by a vote of 2-4.

An amendment to Section 7 to include magazines and junk mail as a regulated recyclable was moved by Legislator Hall and died for lack of a second.

An amendment offered by Legislator Hall to amend Sections 25(a) and 25(b) (see attached) died for lack of a second.

An amendment made by Legislator Hall to add a new Section 27 (see attached) was seconded by Legislator McCaig and was defeated by a vote of 2-4.

An amendment to Sections 2c, 2(1)(6), (2j) and Section 19A was made by Legislator Hall and seconded by Legislator Alfonso and adopted by a vote of 5-1.

A motion made by Legislator Alfonso and seconded by Legislator Roefs to accept the recycling law as amended was adopted by a vote of 4-2.
