

TOWNSHIP OF UPPER CHICHESTER

February 18, 2010

I. CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners was called to order by James R. Stewart, President, at 7:30 P.M., in the Meeting Room of the Municipal Building, Furey Road, Delaware County, Pennsylvania. Mr. Stewart noted that the meeting is being held one week later, due to the snow storm last week. Mr. Stewart conducted the Pledge of Allegiance.
