

PRE-MEETING CONFERENCE

The Pre-Meeting Conference of the City Council of the City of Vineland was called to order by the President, Anthony R. Fanucci.

President Fanucci led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Municipal Clerk stated Public Notice of this meeting, pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act, has been given on December 18, 2012 and January 15, 2013 by the City Clerk in the following manner:

1. Posting written notice on the official bulletin board in the lobby of the City Hall on;
2. Providing written notice to the offices of The Daily Journal and The Press of Atlantic City;
3. Filing written notice in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Vineland.

There was no public comment.

The Municipal Clerk reviewed the changes to the agenda since the February 19 work session. Ordinance No. 2013-10, authorizing the acquisition of one new animal control vehicle for the City of Vineland Police Department, and appropriating \$25,000 therefor from the City of Vineland Capital Improvement Fund for the financing thereof, was added. Ordinance No. 2013-11, providing for the improvements to Well #12 Radionuclide removal treatment plant for the water utility appropriating \$3,000,000 therefor and authorizing the issuance of \$2,850,000 bonds or notes of the City to finance part of the cost thereof, was added. Ordinance No. 2013-12, to amend and supplement Ordinance No. 8 which established the classification and compensation plans for the City of Vineland (Municipal Department Head), was added. The communication from Mayor Bermudez and companion resolution appointing Robert Garcia as Director of the Department of Public Works, were removed. A resolution authorizing the issuance of original and renewal taxicab licenses for the year 2013, was added and assigned No. 2013-83. Resolution No. 2013-102, appointing school crossing guards for the school year 2012-2013, was added. Resolution No. 2013-103, authorizing the issuance of an amendatory supplemental change order No. 1 to contract issued to Parrish Sign Co., Inc. was added. Resolution No. 2013-104, awarding professional services agreements to certain consulting firms to perform the duties of environmental consulting professional, was added. Resolution No. 2013-105, approving membership of Christopher J. Bush to Fire Company No. 2, was added. Revised versions of Resolution Nos. 2013-84, 2013-86, and 2013-94 were distributed.

Councilman Spinelli again expressed his reservations about change orders.

Councilwoman Calakos stated she continues to have difficulty receiving e-mails from her city account.

Business Administrator Monaco announced that paperless agendas will soon be a reality, as the IT department works to get the laptop computers set up.
