

PRE-MEETING CONFERENCE

The Pre-Meeting Conference of the City Council of the City of Vineland was called to order by the President, Anthony R. Fanucci.

President Fanucci led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Municipal Clerk stated Public Notice of this meeting, pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act, has been given on January 15, 2013 by the City Clerk in the following manner:

1. Posting written notice on the official bulletin board in the lobby of the City Hall on;
2. Providing written notice to the offices of The Daily Journal and The Press of Atlantic City;
3. Filing written notice in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Vineland.

President Fanucci asked if anyone from the public wished to speak. Steve Lewis referenced the County Road Department pothole repairing equipment and suggested that it be used to repair ours. President Fanucci responded that Mayor Bermudez is already looking into this. Mr. Lewis also observed that one of the best ways to save money is to listen to employees.

The Municipal Clerk reviewed the changes to the agenda since the April 16 work session. A revised version of Resolution No. 2013-187, authorizing an agreement for professional services with the Gibson Tarquini Group, Inc., Cherry Hill, NJ for the upgrade of HVAC system for the Vineland police building, was distributed. The \$2,000 representing reimbursable expenses was removed after the discussion at last week's work session. Resolution No. 2013-194, appointing Councilman Paul F. Spinelli as a member of the board of directors of the Police Athletic League, was added. Resolution No. 2013-195, appointing Councilman John A. Procopio to the Vineland Downtown Improvement District Management Corporation board of directors, was added. Resolution No. 2013-196, authorizing special law enforcement officers for the year 2013, was added. Resolution No. 2013-197, authorizing the return of funds to the County of Cumberland Prosecutor's Office, was added.

Municipal Clerk Petrosky explained the NJ Ethics Law requirement to file annual Financial Disclosure Statements, which this year must be filed electronically to the state and a receipt delivered to the clerk.
