The Pre-Meeting Conference of the City Council of the City of Vineland was called to order by the President, Anthony R. Fanucci.

The Municipal Clerk stated Public Notice of this meeting, pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act, has been given on April 23, 2013 by the City Clerk in the following manner:

2. Providing written notice to the offices of The Daily Journal and The Press of Atlantic City;
3. Filing written notice in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Vineland.

President Fanucci asked if anyone from the public wished to speak. There was no public comment.

The Municipal Clerk reviewed the changes to the agenda since the June 3 work session. A revised version of Resolution No. 2013-250, approving agreement with the International Association of Emergency Medical Technicians and Paramedics, Local R2-75, was distributed. A revised version of Resolution No. 2013-251, supporting sustainable State funding for preservation and stewardship of open space, parks, farmland and historic sites in New Jersey, was distributed. A revised version of Resolution No. 2013-253, authorizing an agreement for professional services with Gruccio, Pepper, DeSanto & Ruth, PA, for labor attorney services, was distributed. A revised page 3 of Resolution No. 2013-260, granting renewal of alcoholic beverage licenses, was distributed.

Resolution No. 2013-272, authorizing the issuance of limousine licenses for the year 2013, was added. Resolution No. 2013-273, providing for the insertion in the calendar year 2013 budget a special item of revenue made available by revenue realized from NJ Department of Community Affairs, Office of Urban Enterprise Zone First Generation Funding, demolition of properties, 628-630 E. Landis Avenue, in the amount of \$175,000. and an appropriation in said budget for like sum and purpose, was added. Resolution No. 2013-274, approving use of first generation UEZ funds for demolition of properties, 628-630 E. Landis Avenue, was added. A communication from Mayor Bermudez regarding the appointment of Eli Kuhnreich as alternate public defender, was added. Resolution No. 2013-275, appointing Eli Kuhnreich as alternate public defender, was added. Resolution No. 2013-276, authorizing the issuance of original and renewal taxicab licenses for the year 2013, was added. A communication from Mayor Bermudez regarding the appointment of Carmen Valentin as acting assistant City Treasurer, was added. Resolution No. 2013-277, ratifying and confirming the appointment of Carmen Valentin as acting assistant treasurer, was added. Monthly reports from various departments were added.

Gregory Gallo, Department of Administration, was present to review with Council members the features he designed for the paperless agenda. All members have been assigned laptop/tablet device for use at City Council meetings only. Mr. Gallo demonstrated how the meeting agenda is linked to the individual ordinance and resolution documents, which also have a "back to agenda" shortcut. Members extended thanks to Mr. Gallo for his work and to the IS department for providing the equipment. President Fanucci commented how this was done for little or no cost, since the equipment is refurbished and Mr. Gallo designed the agenda and links.
