

PRE-MEETING CONFERENCE
TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 24, 2013

The Pre-Meeting Conference of the City Council of the City of Vineland was called to order by the President, Anthony R. Fanucci.

President Fanucci led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Municipal Clerk stated Public Notice of this meeting, pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act, has been given on April 23, 2013 by the City Clerk in the following manner:

1. Posting written notice on the official bulletin board in the lobby of the City Hall on;
2. Providing written notice to the offices of The Daily Journal and The Press of Atlantic City;
3. Filing written notice in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Vineland.

President Fanucci asked if anyone from the public wished to speak.

Dale Lewis stated that the intersection of Sherman Avenue and the Boulevard is still a problem, with many accidents since the intersection was redesigned by the County. President Fanucci commented that it would make sense to reach out to the County Freeholders after the upcoming election to improve the safety of the intersection.

The Municipal Clerk reviewed the changes to the agenda since the September 17 work session. Resolution No. 2013-410, authorizing the place-to-place transfer (expansion of premises) of alcoholic beverage plenary retail consumption license no. 0614-33-027-011, issued to Double D Saloon, Inc., t/a Double D Saloon, Double D's Gentlemen's Club, located at 1146 South Delsea Drive, was added. The Municipal Clerk explained that the applicant desires to include the rear parking lot to allow patrons to drink while attending outdoor events such as car shows. Councilwomen Calakos and Gonzalez indicated that they are not in favor of this resolution. President Fanucci noted that "straw votes" are not to be taken.
