

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE WARREN COUNTY RIII SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF WARRENTON, MISSOURI FOR SCHOOL CROSSING GUARDS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION I. That the City of Warrenton, Missouri enter into an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement with Warren County R-III School District, under the terms and conditions as set forth in the Contract attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance by reference.

SECTION II. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City said Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement for School Crossing Guards and to do all things necessary to complete this transaction.

SECTION III. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the passage and approval thereof from July 1, 2015 thru June 30, 2016.



**INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE WARREN COUNTY R-III SCHOOL DISTRICT
AND THE CITY OF WARRENTON, MISSOURI FOR CROSSING GUARDS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 70 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, governmental entities, including cities and school districts, are authorized to enter into agreements to provide a common service; and

WHEREAS, the City and the School District both have an interest in the safety of children while they are traveling to and returning from school on city streets; and

WHEREAS, the City and the School District have previously agreed to cooperate and have cooperated in the employment of crossing guards, and now wish to reduce that agreement to writing.

NOW, THEREFORE in consideration of the mutual agreements of the parties as provided herein, the City and School District agree as follows:

1. The City will employ crossing guards to promote the safe passage of the School District's students over City streets during the period of 174 regular school year days, 20 grade and middle school summer school days and 20 high school days from July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016. Four crossing guards will be utilized on each of two different shifts as further agreed to by the parties. The City will pay such crossing guards not more than \$20.00 per day, or a greater amount if required by law. In consideration of the City's agreement to employ such crossing guards to promote the safe passage of the School District's students over City streets during such period, the District agrees to reimburse the City in an amount equal to three-fourths of the amounts paid by the City to employ such crossing guards, together with an amount equal to three-fourths of the ordinary employment taxes attributable to such crossing guards. The School District will pay such amount in ten installments, receiving credit for all amounts previously paid to the City for such purpose for the current fiscal year. The parties agree that the School District does not intend to employ such person or to assume any obligation with respect to such employees, but only to pay the amounts to the City as specified herein.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have executed this agreement effective as of the date that it has been signed by the representatives of the City and the District, as authorized by ordinance of the City and by resolution of the District.
