ORDINANCE NO. 2278

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE WARREN COUNTY R-III SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF WARRENTON, MISSOURI FOR SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION I. That the City of Warrenton enter into a Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement between the Warren County R-III School District and the City of Warrenton, Missouri for employment of police officers as School Resource Officers to interact with students and school faculty and to promote the safety of children, school district patrons, and visitors while they are attending sports and social activities on school properties for 174 days of each school year, as set forth in the Agreement attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance by reference.

SECTION II. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City said Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement and to do all things necessary to complete this transaction.

SECTION III. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the passage and approval thereof.



**INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE WARREN COUNTY R-III SCHOOL DISTRICT
AND THE CITY OF WARRENTON, MISSOURI**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 70 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, governmental entities, including cities and school districts, are authorized to enter into agreements to provide a common service; and

WHEREAS, the City and the School District both have an interest in the safety of children, school district patrons, and visitors while they are attending sports and social activities on school properties;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual agreements of the parties as provided herein, the City and the School District agree as follows:

1. The City will employ police officers, as School Resource Officers to interact with students and school faculty for 174 days of each school year. The School Resource Officers will be utilized as a mentor, counselor, teacher, and assist with security. The City will pay the School Resource Officers at the current salary per hour.

2. In consideration of the City's agreement to employ such police officers to ensure an atmosphere of safety and security and to enhance the overall learning environment, the District agrees to reimburse the City in an amount equal to one-half of the salary paid for such employee during such period, together with an amount equal to one-half (1/2) of such employee's retirement contribution and an amount equal to one-half (1/2) of the ordinary employment taxes attributable to such employee during such period.

3. The School District will pay such amount in nine monthly installments. The City will advise the District of the amount due on or around the first day of each month for the previous month's services. The District will pay the City on or before the twenty-third day of each month for said amount billed.

4. The Parties agree that the School District does not intend to employ such persons.


5. This Agreement may be terminated by either party's giving to the other sixty days written notice of the termination thereof.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties have executed this Agreement, effective as of June 21st, 2016, as authorized by Ordinance of the City and by Resolution of the District.
