

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON, MISSOURI  
ADOPTING THE NFPA-70 NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE 2014**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Alderman of the City of Warrenton, Missouri hereby find that the adoption of the *NFPA-70 National Electrical Code 2014*, as amended, is in the best interest of the general health, welfare and safety of the citizens; and,

**WHEREAS**, §67.280 RSMo provides that local governments may adopt certain technical codes by reference provided that a copy of said codes and all amendments thereto are filed with the Office of the City Clerk for a period of not less than ninety (90) days prior to the date of adoption; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Warrenton filed with the Office of the City Clerk a copy of the *NFPA-70 National Electrical Code 2014* and all proposed amendments thereto for public review and inspection beginning on February 28, 2018, through the date of passage of this ordinance.

THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON, MISSOURI, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. The City of Warrenton, Missouri hereby adopts by reference the *NFPA-70 National Electrical Code 2014*, as amended herein. Section 500.160 of the City's Municipal Code is hereby amended by replacing such section with the following new Section 500.160:

A certain document, one (1) copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Warrenton, being marked and designated as the National Electrical Code, 2014 Edition, as published by the National Fire Protection Association, be and is hereby adopted as the Electrical Code of the City of Warrenton in the State of Missouri; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefore; and each and all the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said Electrical Code on file in the office of the City Clerk are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this Section, with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, prescribed in Section 2 of this Article.

SECTION II. Section 500.170 pertaining to the *NFPA-70 National Electrical Code 2014* is hereby revised with the following amendments:

1. *90.4.1 Creation of enforcement agency.* The Building Department is hereby created and the official in charge thereof shall be known as the Building Commissioner. The Building Commissioner shall be the code official as set forth in the *NFPA-70 National Electrical Code 2014*.
2. *90.4.2 Schedule of permit fees.* A fee for each permit shall be paid as required in accordance with the schedule contained in Warrenton Municipal Code Section **500.040**.
3. *90.4.3 Fee refunds.* See Warrenton Municipal Code Section **500.040(F)**.

4. *90.4.4 General.* The Building Board (Warrenton Municipal Code Section **500.070**) shall hear and decide appeals of orders, decisions or determinations made by the Building Commissioner relative to the application and interpretation of this code. The Board shall adopt rules of procedure for conducting its business.
5. *90.4.5 Violation and penalty.* Any person who shall violate provisions of this Article and the codes adopted herein or shall fail to comply with any of the requirements thereof or who shall perform work in violation of an approved plan or directive of the Building Commissioner or of a permit or certificate issued under the provisions of these codes shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment not exceeding ninety (90) days, or both such fine and imprisonment. Each day that a violation continues shall be deemed a separate offense.
6. *210.12, A Arc-fault Circuit-interrupter protection. All 120-vol, single phase, 15- and 20-ampere branch circuits supplying outlets installed in dwelling unit bedrooms shall be protected by a listed arc-fault circuit interrupter, combination-type installed to provide protection of the branch circuit.*

SECTION III. Section 500.180 pertaining to Violation and Penalty is hereby amended by replacing such section with the following new Section 500.180:


Any person who shall violate provisions of this Article and the codes adopted herein or shall fail to comply with any of the requirements thereof or who shall perform work in violation of an approved plan or directive of the Building Commissioner or of a permit or certificate issued under the provisions of these codes shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment not exceeding ninety (90) days, or both such fine and imprisonment. Each day that a violation continues shall be deemed a separate offense.

SECTION IV. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


SECTION V. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the passage and approval thereof.

SECTION VI. Each and every part, section and subsection of this Ordinance shall be separate and severable from each and every other part, section and subsection hereof. In the event that any part of this Ordinance shall be determined to be unlawful or unconstitutional, the remaining parts, sections and subsections shall remain in full force and effect.


