

AN ORDINANCE DELETING SCHEDULE V "TWO-HOUR PARKING" OF TITLE III "TRAFFIC CODE" IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 365.040 AND INSERTING A NEW SCHEDULE V TITLED "TWENTY-FOUR HOUR PARKING".

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Schedule V, "Two-Hour Parking" of Title III "Traffic Code" is deleted in its entirety and the following Schedule V, "Twenty-Four Hour Parking" is inserted in accordance with Section 365.040 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle for more than twenty-four (24) hours during the times and days set forth in the restrictions upon any of the streets or parts of streets as follows:

Name of Street	Restriction
Highway MM (Main Street) from the west line of Hudson Street, on the south side to the east line of West Street, except the west seventy (70) feet thereof.	Twenty-four hour parking from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. Monday through Friday
From a point directly north of the east intersecting line of Hudson Street with Highway MM (Main Street) to the east line of West Street being the north side of Highway MM.	Twenty-four hour parking from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. Monday through Friday
On both sides of Market Street north and south of Highway MM for a distance to the alleys on each side of Highway MM.	Twenty-four hour parking at all times
On both sides of East Street north and south of Highway MM for a distance to the alleys on each side of Highway MM.	Twenty-four hour parking at all times
On Dryden Street from Highway MM north to the alley on the west side of said street.	Twenty-four hour parking at all times
On Hudson Street from Highway MM south to the alley on both sides of the street.	Twenty-four hour parking at all times
On both sides of South West Street from Highway MM to Walton Street.	Twenty-four hour parking from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. Monday

SECTION II. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION III. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the passage and approval thereof.
